WITH THE CHARTER SET OUT HEREUNDER, THE NEW SOUTH WALES VOLUNTEER RESCUE ASSOCIATION WAS FOUNDED IN THE YEAR 1969 TO BENEFIT THE PUBLIC OF NEW SOUTH WALES BY THE APPLICATION OF THE FOLLOWING TENETS:-

To promote and maintain the New South Wales Volunteer Rescue Association for the following purposes:-

To save, preserve and protect human life and property in day to day situations by the use of approved rescue equipment and techniques.

To co-operate with and assist Commonwealth and State Statutory Services and Defence Forces on request.

To subscribe to, promote and co-operate with constituted organisations whose aims and objectives are compatible with and do not inhibit those of the Association.

To assist in the establishment, training and affiliation with the New South Wales Volunteer Rescue Association of properly constituted rescue squads and organisations for the purpose of improving all forms of day to day rescue.

To promote the standardisation and development of rescue equipment and techniques for the improvement of rescue generally.

To suggest, advise upon and where necessary originate improvements in legislation for the betterment of day to day rescue.
